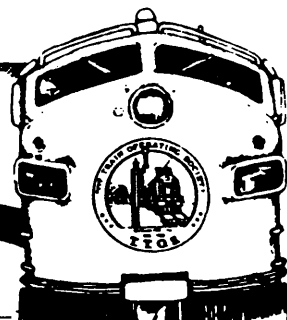

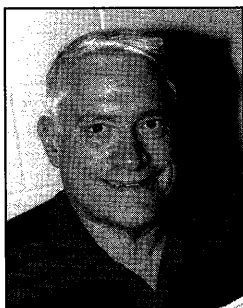

### THE JUNE 13TH MEET REPORT



Thanks for your great support and attendance at the June 13th Meet! It had the largest attendance of any meet at Arcadia since our first return Meet in 2003. Special thanks go to Board Member Hollis Cotton for his special historical presentation on early American Flyer "Hummer" windup trains. With the ongoing energy shortages, windup may again have a future in toy trains. Windup trains give you a train to play

with during a power blackout. (Just kidding.) The auction was great, with one locomotive selling for \$700!

### RUMORS, RUMORS!


It was reported to me all during the latter part of May that at TCA and Southern Pacific Meets rumors were circulating that TTOS Southwestern Division is bankrupt and is going out of business, and that no one should bother to attend our Arcadia Meets, and that Cal-Stewart is being taken over by another TTOS Division. None of this is true! The contracts have been signed and the deposits have been paid for Cal-Stewart 2004. The Southwestern Division of TTOS is separately incorporated, and will survive even if TTOS National and all the other TTOS Divisions expire! The great June Meet proves your support.

Actually, it is my firm belief that all of us should support TTOS and all of its Divisions, as well as TCA, and all the other toy train clubs, wherever possible. This extensive support by toy train lovers will grow and strengthen the hobby for all the clubs.

One possible downside of these negative rumors is that we are experiencing a significant slowdown in Southwestern Membership renewals.
